The CCNA (previously the Paediatric Cardiac Nurses Association) originated in the early 1990s to enable the exchange of ideas, experiences and information for the small but important group of nurses involved in the care of children and young people with congenital heart disease.

In November 2007 the association re-launched as the 'Congenital Cardiac Nurses Association' to reflect changes occurring in practice and to recognise the growing number of children that are surviving into adulthood. We strive to encourage further networking and collaboration with our colleagues in the British Adult Congenital Cardiac Nurses Association (BACCNA) Membership of the association has consequently been expanded to promote the engagement of other healthcare practitioners working in the speciality.

The aims of the CCNA are:

- To act as a discussion forum for health care practitioners engaged or interested in congenital cardiothoracic practice
- To facilitate communication interprofessionally as well as between congenital cardiac centres, nationally and internationally
- To promote dissemination of knowledge
- To act as a body representing the voice of congenital cardiac nurses throughout the UK and Ireland
- To promote the welfare of the child, young person and their family within the sphere of congenital cardiac nursing

The Chairman and Executive Committee representing members meet /teleconference 4 times per annum. Electronic newsletters are produced and email information distributed regularly and when possible there are conferences/ symposiums each year, usually Summer and Autumn (alongside the BCCA/BACCNA).
